



## **Lanai, Hawaii: Hunting Overview**

**Hunting**: Lanai is home to one of the highest densities of free-range Axis Deer in the world. Hunters can expect to see hundreds of deer per day. Hunters will spot and stalk either in a large, flat plain known locally as “the Serengeti,” or in the steep mountainous region that is heavily forested along the shores.

Alternatively, for long range shooters, hunters can set up at shooting benches strategically positioned throughout the island.

**Suggested Packing List**: Lanai, Hawaii has a beautifully mild climate year-round, and you will rarely experience temperatures cooler than 65 degrees or warmer than 80 degrees Fahrenheit. Lightweight hunting gear is recommended. Sturdy boots with gaiters are also recommended to keep you comfortable while traversing volcanic rock.
